- Signature design element is a private club for 150 fans on the suite level directly behind home plate. The private club can be used as a meeting venue by local organizations and features interior lounge space and an upscale bar area with a field view
- Press box is located along the third base line
- Columbus (Ga.) Catfish are expected to relocate and start play in Bowling Green in 2009
